**1. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.**

Cllr de Galleani declared a personal interest in agenda item 3 – Devon County Council Consultation on Community Composting and Recycling Centres.

**2. DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL CONSULTATION ON COMMUNITY COMPOSTING AND RECYCLING CENTRES.**

Details of a Devon County Council consultation on Community Composting and modifications to the Chargeable Waste Scheme had been circulated to members. The meeting noted the proposal to extend the exclusion on vehicles using the Household Waste Recycling Centres to include pickup trucks towing trailers and long wheel base vans (in excess of 6 metres in total length). The changes to the Community Composting credit rate did not affect Dartmouth at present.

### **3. SOUTH HAMS DISTRICT COUNCIL CONSULTATION ON LITTER COLLECTION AND SWEEPING.**

Details of a South Hams District Council Street Cleansing Reflection had been circulated to members, together with the zoning map showing the street sweeping zones in Dartmouth.

Comments were required by 1<sup>st</sup> December 2016 on Litter Collection, Sweeping and Dog bins.

The Chairman told members that a meeting had been held at the Guildhall between officers from South Hams District Council and members of the Town Council to discuss the current street cleansing provision and following this the link to a map showing the cleaning zones for Dartmouth had been received.

The meeting noted the following points:-

- The blue line by Dart Marina Hotel showed street cleaning along the edge of the river and should be in Sandquay Road which appeared to have been missed off the cleaning rota.
- The new dog bin in South Ford Road had been placed at one end near Vicarage Hill (20 yards from another bin) and should be moved to the middle of South Ford Road.
- A cleaning rota for the sets of steps along the embankment and ferry slip areas was needed.
- The unsurfaced path up Jawbones Hill to the Old Abattoir was listed on the “pink” rota.
- An additional litter bin was required near to “Vino’s” takeaway in Victoria Road.
- A plan of the litter bins in Dartmouth was awaited from South Hams District Council.

### **4. GRANTS FROM THE SOUTH HAMS TOWN AND PARISH FUND 2016/2017.**

Details of the Town and Parish Fund for 2016/2017 had been circulated to members; the deadline for applications was 16<sup>th</sup> December 2016.

At present members were not able to identify any suitable projects to meet the criteria for grants from the Town and Parish fund. The Clerk would contact the other parishes in the Eastern Cluster and would arrange a meeting with the Chairman of Stoke Fleming Parish Council.
