**READVERTISEMENT (Revised plans received)**. Householder application for single storey rear extension with enlarged balcony.

#### 9 Mount Boone

A member of the public spoke on behalf of neighbours who were opposed to the application. Recommend Refusal on the grounds that the application would cause loss of light and visual amenity to the neighbouring properties, is Overbearing and Dominant, would cause loss of Privacy in the main rooms of neighbouring properties, not in keeping with an Edwardian property or the street scene and would be setting a precedent. The Committee noted that there didn't appear to have been a noticeable change to the previous plans. In view of the large number of objections received by the Town Council, the Planning Committee are requesting that the application is taken to the Development Management Committee for consideration.
