Extract from the Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order, 1974

Section 9(4) “No body shall be buried, or cremated human remains interred or scattered, in or over any grave, walled grave or vault in which an exclusive right of burial for the time being subsists except by or with the consent in writing of the owner of the right”.

Schedule 2(ii(4)) “A person to whom any such right is assigned or transmitted shall not be entitled to its exercise until he has notified the assignment or transmission to the burial authority in writing.....”
